-Facts at a glance-

Surgical Procedure

- The incisions are made either in the mouth or under the chin. The surgeon sculpts the bone to a more pleasing size. For orthognathic surgery, the surgeon will make an incision inside the mouth and reposition the facial bones. The procedure, depending on the extent of the work, takes from less than an hour to approximately three hours.

Duration of Operation

- Thirty minutes

Risks and Complications

- The main risks are swelling, bruising, bleeding, infection, scarring and numbness, or change in sensation.

After Care

- After surgery, the surgeon usually applies a dressing that will remain in place for two to three days. You will experience some tenderness. Post-operative discomfort can be controlled with prescribed medications. Chewing will probably be limited immediately after chin surgery, and a liquid and soft food diet may be required for a few days after surgery. Most patients feel a stretched, tight sensation after the surgery, but this usually subsides in a week.

Recovery

- After approximately six weeks, most swelling will be gone, and you can enjoy the results of your procedure. Rigorous activity may be prohibited for the first few weeks after surgery. Normal activity can be resumed after approximately ten days.

Result

- A classically-shaped face contoured to maximize prevalent norms of attractiveness and beauty.

Hospital Admission

- One night admission to hospital.

Anesthetic

- General Anesthesia (you are asleep)

Pre Operative Care

- Tell your doctor about any allergies you have (to foods, drugs, environmental elements) Avoid aspirin and aspirin-containing medicines for two weeks prior to surgery.

Post Operative Care

- Your plastic surgeon will provide you with instructions about post-operative care. There will be dietary restrictions as well as limitations to your activities. However, you should be aware that your ability to move your mouth and lips may be diminished temporarily.

Medical Documents

- Completed all medical tests (blood pressure, BUN, CBC, prothrombin & partial thromboplastin times, chest x-ray, EKG, HIV)

Passport and Visa

- Plastic surgery thailand - Chin Shaving with Dr. Saran Wannachamras bangkok, Thailand.
- Please forward the copy of your passport to us before the arriving date.
- US citizens can call San Francisco information (415) 744-4444 or you can search under "U.S. Government offices" in the white pages to find the phone number of your local passport office.
- For most tourists, a stay of no more than 30 days does not require a VISA. For further information on Thailand's entry/exit requirements, please contact the Thai consulate in your country or your travel agent.

- Our recommended airlines are Thai International, Northwest, Lufthansa, Singapore, and EVA which has wide seats.

Expenses

- If you are HIV positive, then you are a risk to hospital personel. For this reason you need to pay an extra 30% to the original charge.

Airport Immigration and Customs

- Please present the supporting documents confirming the scheduled operation upon request. Please do not carry any unnecessary drugs or dangerous objects in your luggage.

Appointment

FAQ : Criteria

Who is a candidate for Chin Surgery ?

In general, the best candidates for chin surgery are people :

- In good physical health.
- Psychologically stable.
- Wanting to add definition to the face, especially the upper face.
- Understanding the healing process.
- Understanding the limitations of the procedure.
- No known allergies to the implant material used.
- Having realistic expectations for the outcome.
- The above is only a partial list of the criteria that your surgeon will consider in determining whether or not this procedure is appropriate for you. Be sure to ask your surgeon if he / she considers you an ideal candidate for chin surgery.

FAQ : Surgical Procedure

What will I need to do before the surgery?

Prior to your surgery you will be seen in the office for a consultation with your physician concerning the extent of the procedure and to discuss the results that can be expected. Special attention will be paid to the structure of the face. There will be photographs taken before and after your surgery so that you can compare the improvements of your surgery. Other subjects that will be discussed in the consultation include the type of anesthesia (local or general) to be used and the risks involved. You may also be given some presurgery instructions that could include eliminating the use of aspirin for several weeks prior to the surgery to help avoid excess bleeding. Sometimes antibiotics are prescribed to help prevent infection.

How much pain is there?

The amount of pain depends on the method used, and varies from person to person. Local anesthetic is used to reduce pain during the surgery.

What does the surgery consist of?

The surgery will usually begin with you receiving some medication to help you relax. Once the anesthesia has taken effect the doctor will begin the procedure by making incisions inside the mouth or under the chin. If the chin bone is to be moved forward the physician will complete the procedure through the incision in the mouth. If the procedure involves the placement of a prosthetic chin implant then the procedure may only require one small incision under the chin. The entire procedure could take two hours or more depending on the procedures to be performed.

What should I expect following the procedure?

After the procedure is complete a compression dressing is applied to the area to prevent bleeding and excess swelling. The dressings will usually be removed within a week. Any pain you experience will be mild to moderate and can be controlled by oral medications. There may be some bruising and swelling

around the treated areas. Swelling can be reduced by keeping your head elevated when reclining. Most people are completely ambulatory immediately following this procedure, but rest is recommended for the first day after surgery. Patients are usually able to return to normal activities within a week, although strenuous exercise should be avoided for several weeks along with any other activities that may cause a rise in your blood pressure. Chewing and brushing teeth may be difficult for a time following the surgery.

How quick is recovery from Chin Surgery?

You will experience some discomfort and swelling in the affected area for several days. It's normal to experience some temporary difficulty with smiling and talking. Black and blue marks may be visible around the chin and neck. Your plastic surgeon will instruct you about dental hygiene, eating and any restrictions to your activities after surgery.

FAQ : Result

What are some of the most common benefits of this surgery?

Chin Augmentation may augment the jaw to correct problems with weak chins, sagging skin in the chin area, and improve the shape and balance of the face.

What is the long-term outcome like for most people?

Due to swelling, the results of the surgery may not be plainly visible for as long as three or four months. Scars are generally well hidden.
